## How to register for a NoodleTools® account:

1. Go to **Noodletools.com** and click “Log In”
2. Click “Register” and select “An account linked to a school/library”
3. Fill in the following Subscription Information:  
School/Library Username: **WCmtsac**  
School/Library Password: **password**
4. Click “Continue” and establish a Personal ID (be sure to write it down)
5. Click “Register.” You’re now in and able to use NoodleTools®!
