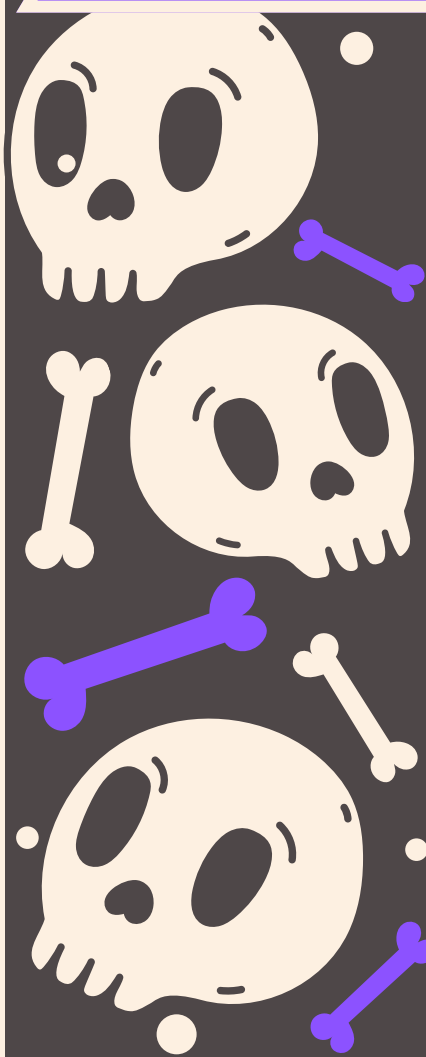




The Writing Center's October Writing Contest

Write a poem (any form, 30 lines max) about the "monsters" we create out of fear, jealousy, rumors, greed, etc. Your poem can be dark, funny, or reflective.
