- Nursing assistants are important health care professionals who handle the day-to-day care of patients
- There is currently a high demand for Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs), Acute Care Nursing Assistants, and Certified Home Health Aides in Southern California and throughout the state
- The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics lists nursing assistants as one of the fastest-growing occupations in the United States

- Approved by the California Board of Registered Nursing
- A two-year program designed to prepare individuals to give direct nursing care to clients in various practice settings
- The program consists of course work in nursing, science, general education, and clinical nursing practice at local hospitals and health agencies
- Graduates of the program receive an Associate in Science Degree in Nursing and are eligible to take the NCLEX-RN examination leading to licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN)

- You can also take major preparation courses for transfer to four-year pre-licensure BSN programs.
- Mt. SAC has a partnership with Mount St. Mary's RN to BSN program

- Visit the <u>Nursing program website</u> to become familiar with the multiple screening criteria and lottery selection process, and program information

- Research the <u>CSU</u> and/or <u>UC</u> prelicensure BSN programs (e.g. CSULA, CSULB, CSUSB, UCI, UCLA, etc.)
- Review<u>assist.org</u> to search for major preparation requirements for CSU/UC
- Consider earning an Associate
 Degree in Nursing (ADN) before
 transferring to a university
- Review <u>Mount St. Mary's RN- BSN</u>
 program for Mt. SAC ADN graduates
